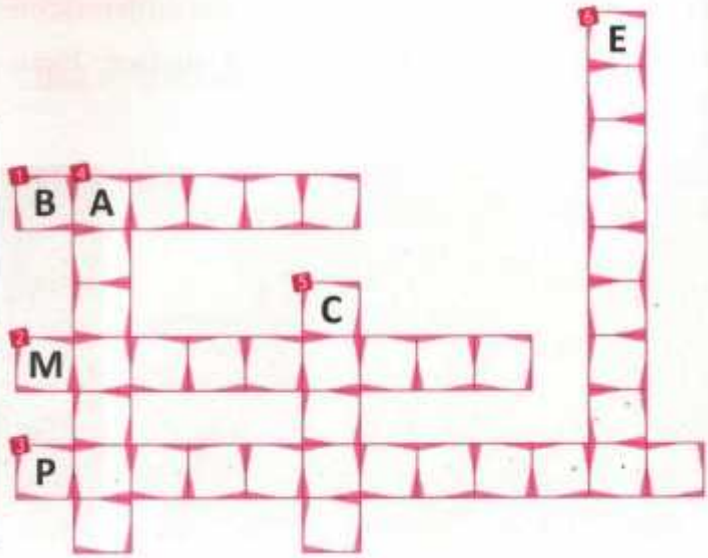

Most animals including fish, mammals, reptiles and birds have very simple life cycles. They are born either alive from their mother or get hatched from eggs. They grow up. These animals have three stages-before birth, young and adult.

Amphibians undergo a metamorphosis or a big change. They are born either alive from their mother or are hatched from eggs. They spend their childhood under water, breathing with gills. They grow into adults and move to the land, breathing with their lungs.

Insects such as butterflies, have four stages in their life cycle-egg or the unborn stage; larva or the young stage when most of the feeding is done and the insect usually looks like a worm. Pupa is the inactive or no feeding stage between larva and adult stages. This is followed by the adult stage.

Dragonflies, grasshoppers and cockroaches are insects that go through an incomplete metamorphosis. They do not have a pupal form and have three stages in their life cycle, namely, egg; nymph or young stage and adult stage.
